Order of the Office of Central Company and Partnership Registry

No. 57/2557

Re: Establishment of Office of Company and Partnership Registry, Appointment of Assistants to the Central Registrar and Registrar

By virtue of article 2 and article 3 of the Ministerial Regulation on Establishment of Office of Company and Partnership Registry, Appointment of Registrar and Prescription of Rules and Procedures for Registration of Partnerships and Limited Companies B.E. 2549 (2006) issued by virtue of the Civil and Commercial Code, as amended by Ministerial Regulation on Establishment of Office of Company and Partnership Registration, Appointment of Registrar and Prescription of Rules and Procedures for Registration of Partnerships and Companies (No. 2) B.E. 2553 (2010), the Central Registrar hereby issues the following Order:

Article 1. Order of the Central Office of Company and Partnership Registry No. 44/2555 Re: Establishment of Office of Company and Partnership Registry, Appointment of Assistant Central Registrar and Registrar, dated 24th April B.E. 2555 (2012), shall be repealed.

Article 2. The Department of Business Development and Office of Business Development Districts 1-6 shall be Offices of Company and Partnership Registration to perform registration functions pertaining to partnerships and limited companies with head offices situated in the area of Bangkok Metropolis.

Article 3. The Provincial Office of Business Development and Branch of the Provincial Office of Business Development shall be the Office of Company and Partnership Registration to perform registration functions pertaining to partnerships and limited companies with head offices situated in the area of such province.

Article 4. The following government officials are appointed as Assistants to the Central Registrar to perform registration functions pertaining to partnerships and limited companies whose head offices are situated in the area of Bangkok Metropolis and other provinces throughout the entire Kingdom:

- (1) Deputy Director-General of the Department of Business Development;
- (2) Director of the Office of Business Registration;
- (3) Director of the Office of Business Data;
- (4) Director of the Office of Business Accounts Supervision;
- (5) Director of the Office of Business Accounts Development;
- (6) Director of the Legal Office;
- (7) Director of the Regional Office of Commerce;
- (8) Director of the Office of Business Governance.

Article 5. The Director of Central Business Registration Division, Songkhla Provincial Business Development Registrar, shall be an Assistant to the Central Registrar charged with registration functions for partnerships and limited companies with head offices situated in the areas of Pattani, Yala and Narathiwat Provinces.

Article 6. The Director of Central Business Registration Division, Director of Provincial Business Development Office and technical civil servants at senior professional level in the Office of Business Registration, Regional Office of Business Registration, Provincial Business Development Office and Branch of Provincial Business Development Office shall be Assistants to the Central Registrar charged with registration functions pertaining to the establishment of partnerships and limited companies with head offices situated in the area of Bangkok Metropolis and other provinces throughout the entire Kingdom.

Article 7. General civil servants at operational level who have served in the official service for not less than five years and those at experienced level or higher, and technical civil servants at practitioner level in the Office of Business Registration, Office of Business Data, Office of Business Supervision, Office of Business Accounts Development, Legal Office, Regional Office of Commerce, Office of Business Governance, Department of Business Development are appointed as Registrars for:

(1) performing registration functions pertaining to partnerships and limited companies with head offices situated in the area of Bangkok Metropolis; and

(2) performing functions relating to the inspection of documents, verification of registry entries (certification) and certification of registry document copies pertaining to partnerships and limited companies, including the inspection of registry entry certificates (certificate) and certification of registration electronic documents of partnerships and limited companies throughout the entire Kingdom.

Article 8. General civil servants at operational level who have served in the official service for not less than five years and experienced level or higher, and technical civil servants at practitioner level in the Provincial Business Development Office are appointed as Registrars for:

(1) performing registration functions pertaining to partnerships and limited companies with head offices situated in such provincial area; and

(2) performing functions relating to the inspection of documents, verification of registry entries (certification) and certification of registry document copies pertaining to partnerships and limited companies, including the inspection of registry entry certificates (certificate) and certification of registration electronic documents of partnerships and limited companies throughout the entire Kingdom.

Article 9. In the case where a Provincial Business Development Office does not have a civil servant under article 8, or such civil servant is not present or unable to perform

duties, the civil servants in the following order shall be the Registrar for performing duties as prescribed under article 8:

(1) Provincial Commercial Officer;

(2) Acting Provincial Commercial Officer in the case where the Provincial Commercial Officer is not present or unable to perform duties;

(3) a general civil servant of operational level who have served in the official service for not less than five years and experienced level or higher, and technical civil servants at practitioner level in the Provincial Business Development Office, in order of seniority, in the case where there is no Acting Provincial Commercial Officer, or the Acting Provincial Commercial Officer is not present or unable to perform duties.

This Order shall come into force as from 2nd June B.E. 2557 (2014).
